



F 29 Certification/Registration Process

LIFEGUARD REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Application

Read and understand the assessment process and criteria

Fill out the application

Submit proof of lifeguard training. It is not required to take the prerequisite training from SST.

Submit proof of DCAS approved first aid and CPR training. It is not required to take the prerequisite training from SST.

Submit one passport sized photo

Submit passport and visa and/OR Emirates ID

Payment of assessment fee

Confirm information about dress code and rules for pool use

Read and sign code of ethics and substance abuse policy

Step 2: Assessment

Attend examination as scheduled
Arrive at least 15 minutes early
Have all documentation and ID to gain access to the examination
Have appropriate clothes and a towel for the pool
Have a set of dry clothes for the written exam
Exam criteria will be given to you during registration and reviewed before the exams
Written exam may be administered before or after the practical exam
The examination will take between 3- 6 hours
If the exam goes beyond four hours, there will be a lunch/prayer break

Step 3: Certification Validation

Review of all exam documentation and results by certifying body

Approval by certifying body

Email confirmation with exam results will be sent to the candidate within four working days

Certificate and card will be issued to successful candidates within 10 working days of the declaration of results
